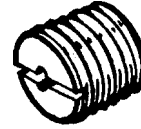


## TOUCH HOLE LINERS

### Standard Touch Hole Liners

Touch Hole Liner for flintlock ignition rifles and pistols. Liners are coned on the inside to allow the powder charge to sit closer to the priming powder for a quicker ignition time. Machined from #303 stainless steel with a screwdriver slot for easy installation and removal.

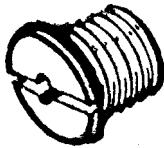
Hole diameter 1/16".

### Tapered Touch Hole Liner

Stainless steel touch hole liner coned on the inside for fast ignition. Made with a tapered head to fit a standard counter sink so as to shoulder up flush with the barrel.

Hole diameter 1/16".

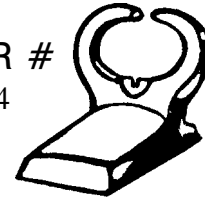
## SIGHTS

### Buckhorn Sights

Traditional full Buckhorn rear sight made of wax cast steel with a 5/8" long dovetail base. Height is 1/4" from top of base to bottom of notch. Notch may be filed to your desired shape and size.

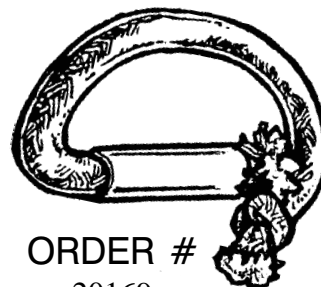

Same traditional design as the sight above, except that it has a standard 3/8" dovetail base to fit most conventional rifles.

### Tinder Tube

Tinder Tubes have been used for centuries as a fire starting tool. To use, simply ignite the charred end of the cord with flint and steel striker, then use as you would char cloth to start a fire or light a pipe. To extinguish simply pull cord back into tube.
